

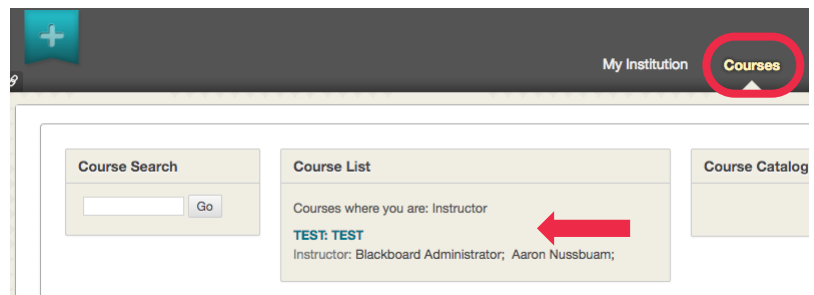
Blackboard Integration Instructor Guide

The steps below will guide you through integrating MobLab with your Blackboard Learning Management System. Before starting this process, it is recommended you contact your Blackboard Administrator. A Blackboard Administrator is needed to first add the tool. See the Blackboard Administrator Instructions for details.

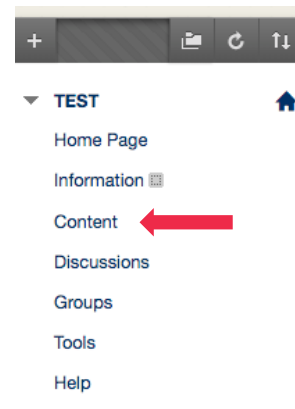
If your campus installation of Blackboard looks different from what is presented below, please contact your MobLab rep to discuss the details.

Steps for an Instructor after a Blackboard Administrator adds the MobLab Tool:

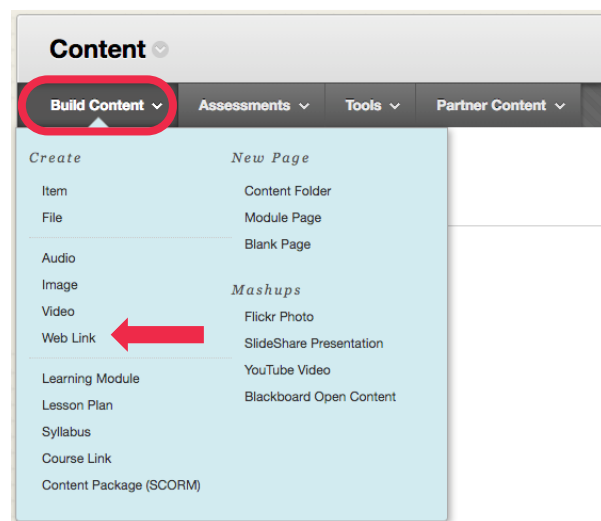
1. Navigate to your Courses and select your desired course from the Course List



2. Select Content from the left-side bar.



3. Select **Build Content** and choose to build a **Web Link**.



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4. To create the Web Link, enter the following information:

5. Scroll to Weblink Options and be sure to select **Yes** for Open in New Window

6. Scroll to the section on Standard Options and be sure to select **No** for both **Permit Users to View this Content** And **Track Number of Views**

Click **Submit** to proceed.


7. When finished, you will see the MobLab app added under Content.

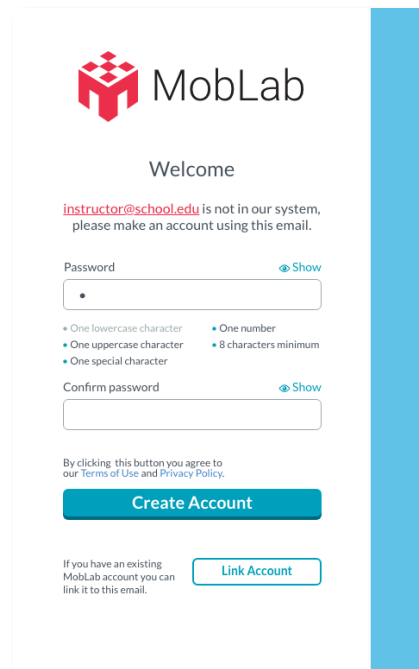

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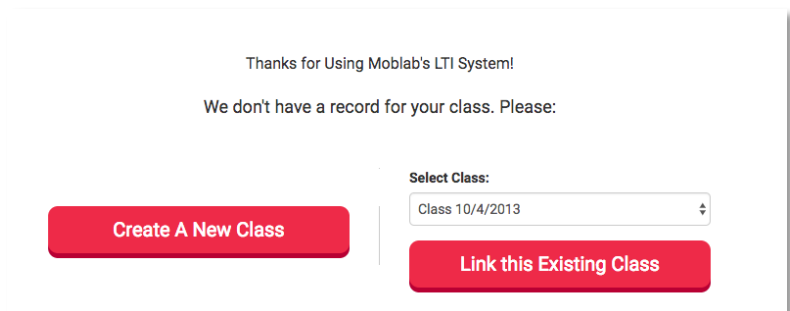
8. First, we'll check if your Blackboard username matches a MobLab username. If so, you'll be asked to log into your existing MobLab account.

If not, you'll be asked to create a new MobLab instructor account.

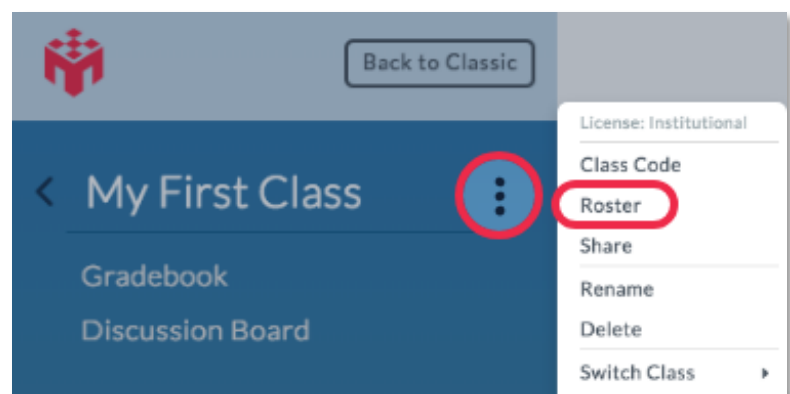


9. Once logged in, you can choose to create a new class or link an existing MobLab class.

If you needed to create your MobLab instructor account, a new class will automatically be created for you.

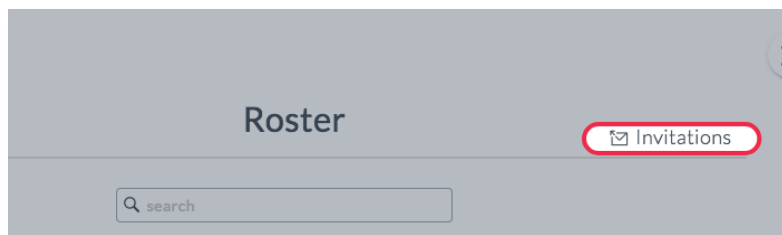


10. Once in the instructor console, open your class roster to send student's email invitations.

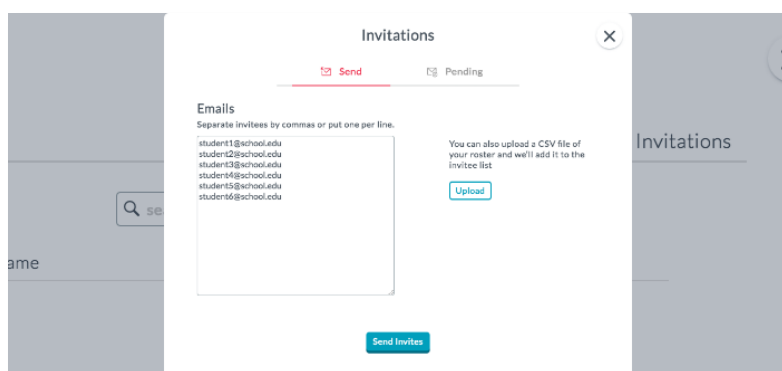


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11. Click on the Invitations link which will pull your students' emails from Blackboard.



12. Click **Send Invites** so students have information they need to join your class.



Be sure to communicate with your students that they should expect this invitation to arrive from MobLab, and that it is **necessary** they sign up with the email address which is linked to their Blackboard account. If they don't use this username as their MobLab username, their grades won't sync between the two platforms.
